

Important Notice regarding GL2021

Amsterdam, 12 November 2021

Today, the Dutch Government has announced new measures to combat the surge in COVID-19 cases in The Netherlands. These measures severely impact next month's scheduled International Conference on Grey Literature. The onsite conference will be cancelled and on December 6, 2021 all of the pre-recorded presentations will be openly accessible via an online media platform. The link will be posted in advance via GreyNet's Distribution List and social media.

As stated in earlier correspondence, the due date for your MP4 pre-recorded presentation is November 30, 2021.

All of the pre-recorded presentations that were selected for Plenary Sessions will be uploaded in GreyNet's Collection of conference videos housed in the TIB AV-Portal along with accompanying metadata and an assigned DOI.

Your accompanying full-text conference paper is due by January 10, 2022 and will be published in the GL2021 Conference Proceedings. ISBN 978-90-77484-40-1. – ISSN 1386-2316

Research data/datasets that form the basis for conference papers will be published in the DANS Easy Archive along with accompanying metadata and an assigned DOI.

All conference papers published in the Conference Proceedings will be eligible for republication as journal articles in The Grey Journal e-ISSN 1574-180X licensed by EBSCO Publishing and abstracted and indexed by Scopus and other A&I services.

On December 1, 2021 the link to this year's display of Conference Posters and abstracts will be announced and opened for viewing and balloting. As a member and/or subscriber to GreyNet's distribution list and social media, you will be asked to judge the poster submissions to the Twenty-Third International Conference on Grey Literature. Criteria for best conference poster will deal with its innovative content, relevance to the conference topics, graphic design, and its accompanying abstract.
