## Guidelines for Poster Abstracts

Individuals seeking to present a poster during the 'Global Forum for Publishers in Grey Literature' are invited to submit an English language abstract between 200-300 words. The abstract should describe the project, activity, information product or service. The abstract should likewise include a title, name(s) of the creator(s) and full address information. Abstracts are an important source of information made available prior to the event that will be accessible to the delegates and participants.

## Due Date for Submission of Abstracts

Timely registration is a guarantee for your placement on the program. Abstracts in MSWord should be emailed to [info@greynet.org](mailto:info@greynet.org) on or before **May 5<sup>th</sup> 2026**. Those submitting poster abstracts will receive verification upon their receipt followed by further guidelines for posters, registration, etc.

## Poster Presentations

Your **physical** poster (maximum size A0 (841 x 1189 mm / 33.1 x 46.8 in) will be on display on both days of the event. Those presenting can bring their poster with them or ship it in advance to the postal address shown below. Brief introductions to the posters will be presented on the afternoon of [Day One](#) and the 'Poster Session and Sponsor Showcase' will follow on the morning of [Day Two](#). Individuals are also encouraged to submit their **poster in digital format** along with an MP4 pre-recorded presentation that will be later published and openly accessible on the [TIB AV-Portal](#). Further details will follow.

## Poster Prize 2026

Those presenting posters are also eligible for the Poster Prize 2026. The winning poster will be announced during the Closing Session. Posters will be judged by a panel of jurors based on their innovative content, relevance to the forum topics, graphic design, and accompanying abstract.
